“Be Doers of the Word”

James 1:22: “But be doers of the word, and not hearers only, deceiving yourselves.”

Day 1 – Tuesday, June 27th

Hebrews 4:12: For the word of God is living and active, sharper than any two-edged sword, piercing to the division of soul and of spirit, of joints and of marrow, and discerning the thoughts and intentions of the heart.

Day 2 – Wednesday, June 28th

2 Timothy 3:16-17: All Scripture is breathed out by God and profitable for teaching, for reproof, for correction, and for training in righteousness, that the man of God may be complete, equipped for every good work.

Day 3 – Thursday, June 29th

Psalms 119:105: Your word is a lamp to my feet and a light to my path.

Day 4 – Friday, June 30th

Psalms 119:9: How can a young man keep his way pure? By guarding it according to your word.

Day 5 – Saturday, July 1st

Isaiah 40:8: The grass withers, the flower fades, but the word of our God will stand forever.

Day 6 – Sunday, July 2nd

Luke 11:28: But he said, “Blessed rather are those who hear the word of God and keep it!”

Day 7 – Monday, July 3rd

Matthew 7:24: Everyone then who hears these words of mine and does them will be like a wise man who built his house on the rock.

Day 8 – Tuesday, July 4th

Psalm 18:30: This God—his way is perfect; the word of the Lord proves true; he is a shield for all those who take refuge in him.

Day 9 – Wednesday, July 5th

Philippians 2:14-16: Do all things without grumbling or disputing, that you may be blameless and innocent, children of God without blemish in the midst of a crooked and twisted generation, among whom you shine as lights in the world, holding fast to the word of life.

Day 10 – Thursday, July 6th

Matthew 24:35: Heaven and earth will pass away, but my words will not pass away.

Day 11 – Friday, July 7th

Psalm 119:130: The unfolding of your words gives light; it imparts understanding to the simple.

Day 12 – Saturday, July 8th

Psalm 33:4: For the word of the Lord is upright, and all his work is done in faithfulness.

Day 13 – Sunday, July 9th

1 Peter 2:2: Like newborn infants, long for the pure spiritual milk, that by it you may grow up into salvation.

Day 14 – Monday, July 10th

Proverbs 2:6: For the Lord gives wisdom; from his mouth come knowledge and understanding.

Day 15 – Tuesday, July 11th

John 8:31-32: So Jesus said to the Jews who had believed him, “If you abide in my word, you are truly my disciples, and you will know the truth, and the truth will set you free.”

Day 16 – Wednesday, July 12th

James 1:21: Therefore put away all filthiness and rampant wickedness and receive with meekness the implanted word, which is able to save your souls.

Day 17 – Thursday, July 13th

Deuteronomy 8:3: And he humbled you and let you hunger and fed you with manna, which you did not know, nor did your fathers know, that he might make you know that man does not live by bread alone, but man lives by every word that comes from the mouth of the Lord.

Day 18 – Friday, July 14th

Psalms 119:160: The sum of your word is truth, and every one of your righteous rules endures forever.

Day 19 – Saturday, July 15th

Isaiah 55:11: So shall my word be that goes out from my mouth; it shall not return to me empty, but it shall accomplish that which I purpose, and shall succeed in the thing for which I sent it.

Day 20 – Sunday, July 16th

Psalms 130:5: I wait for the Lord, my soul waits, and in his word I hope.

Day 21 – Monday, July 17th

Proverbs 30:5: Every word of God proves true; he is a shield to those who take refuge in him.

Day 22 – Tuesday, July 18th

Psalms 119:11: I have stored up your word in my heart that I might not sin against you.

Day 23 – Wednesday, July 19th

1 Peter 1:23: Since you have been born again, not of perishable seed but of imperishable, through the living and abiding word of God.

Day 24 – Thursday, July 20th

Colossians 3:16: Let the word of Christ dwell in you richly, teaching and admonishing one another in all wisdom, singing psalms and hymns and spiritual songs, with thankfulness in your hearts to God.

Day 25 – Friday, July 21st

2 Samuel 22:31: This God—his way is perfect; the word of the Lord proves true; he is a shield for all those who take refuge in him.

Day 26 – Saturday, July 22nd

Job 23:12: I have not departed from the commandment of his lips; I have treasured the words of his mouth more than my portion of food.

Day 27 – Sunday, July 23rd

Exodus 19:5: Now therefore, if you will indeed obey my voice and keep my covenant, you shall be my treasured possession among all peoples, for all the earth is mine;

Day 28 – Monday, July 24th

Deuteronomy 11:1: "You shall therefore love the LORD your God and keep his charge, his statutes, his rules, and his commandments always."

Day 29 – Tuesday, July 25th

2 Corinthians 10:5: We destroy arguments and every lofty opinion raised against the knowledge of God, and take every thought captive to obey Christ.

Day 30 – Wednesday, July 26th

Revelation 14:12: Here is a call for the endurance of the saints, those who keep the commandments of God and their faith in Jesus.

Day 31 – Thursday, July 27th

2 John 1:6: And this is love that we walk according to his commandments; this is the commandment, just as you have heard from the beginning, so that you should walk in it.

Day 32 – Friday, July 28th

Deuteronomy 28:1-2: "And if you faithfully obey the voice of the LORD your God, being careful to do all his commandments that I command you today, the LORD your God will set you high above all the nations of the earth. And all these blessings shall come upon you and overtake you, if you obey the voice of the LORD your God.

Day 33 – Saturday, July 29th

Proverbs 3:5-6: Trust in the LORD with all your heart, and do not lean on your own understanding. In all your ways acknowledge him, and he will make straight your paths.

Day 34 – Sunday, July 30th

Proverbs 2:1-2: My son, if you receive my words and treasure up my commandments with you, making your ear attentive to wisdom and inclining your heart to understanding;

Day 35 – Monday, July 31st

Proverbs 2:6-8: For the LORD gives wisdom; from his mouth come knowledge and understanding; he stores up sound wisdom for the upright; he is a shield to those who walk in integrity, guarding the paths of justice and watching over the way of his saints.

Day 36 – Tuesday, August 1st

1 Thessalonians 2:13: And we also thank God constantly for this, that when you received the word of God, which you heard from us, you accepted it not as the word of men but as what it really is, the word of God, which is at work in you believers.

Day 37 – Wednesday, August 2nd

Hebrews 5:13-14: for everyone who lives on milk is unskilled in the word of righteousness, since he is a child. But solid food is for the mature, for those who have their powers of discernment trained by constant practice to distinguish good from evil.

Day 38 – Thursday, August 3rd

Romans 15:4: For whatever was written in former days was written for our instruction, that through endurance and through the encouragement of the Scriptures we might have hope.

Day 39 – Friday, August 4th

Proverbs 3:1-2: My son, do not forget my teaching, but let your heart keep my commandments, for length of days and years of life and peace they will add to you.

Day 40 – Saturday, August 5th

James 1:22: But be doers of the word, and not hearers only, deceiving yourselves.
